

RIGHTS CERTIFICATE

GS1 Azerbaijan

- 1. GS1 (formerly called EAN International), is a voluntary, not-for-profit, international association with a Head Office in Brussels, Belgium. GS1 currently has a membership of over 100 nationally based Member Organisations. It manages a worldwide, multi-industry standards system enabling the automatic identification of products and services in the supply chain, electronic commerce and global data synchronisation. The GS1 standards system uses bar-coding and radio frequency identification technologies.
- GS1 Member Organisations are authorised by GS1 to administer the GS1
 System in their own territory and as such are the sole representatives of GS1 for
 that territory. To ensure the global uniqueness of GS1 identification numbers and
 the integrity of the GS1 System, there can only be one GS1 Member Organisation
 per national territory.
- 3. GS1 Azerbaijan has been a Member Organisation of GS1 since 1999. GS1 has granted GS1 Azerbaijan an exclusive licence to administer the GS1 System in Azerbaijan and allocate GS1 identification numbers to companies, under Prefix 476, for their supply chain management needs. It is the sole representative of GS1 in Azerbaijan.
- 4. **Trademarks.** By virtue of its membership in **GS1** and on the basis of an "Agreement on Intellectual Property and Data Management" entered into between GS1 and GS1 Azerbaijan, **GS1 Azerbaijan** has the exclusive right to use the '**GS1**' trademarks in **Azerbaijan**.
- 5. Copyright rights. GS1 Azerbaijan has the exclusive right to copy, translate, reproduce and distribute GS1 publications including the GS1 General Specifications, the GS1 Global User Manual, the GS1 EANCOM manual and other publications published from time to time by GS1. These copyright rights include the right to produce publications that derive from and are compliant with GS1 standards and publications.
